Severe Weather Procedure: If conditions are favorable for a storm, please keep your eyes on the skies.

If there is a severe warning, the siren will sound, and you should be prepared to move to the nearest Comfort Station (Restroom). This does not include the Ranger Station.

When it storms, with high winds, lightning, hail and rain, the pools will be closed until skies clear.

We are located in Marshall County. The surrounding counties are Starke (West), Kosciusko (East), Fulton (South), and St Joseph (North). Also included are area counties (LaPorte and Porter (Northwest), Pulaski (South West), Elkhart (Northeast), and Wabash (Southeast).

Jellystone Park™ Rules

Rules & Regulations so that we may all enjoy Plymouth Jellystone Park™

1. Check out is 1:00 p.m. (EST). No late checkout. Check in is 3:00 p.m. (EST).
2. Park speed limit is 5 ½ mph. Guests that violate speed limit, stop sign rules etc. will be subject to a cash fines as follows:
 - A. Failure to Stop at Stop signs: First (1st) offense \$5.00 fine. Second (2nd) offense \$10.00 fine. Third (3rd) offense appear before the Board of Directors
 - B. Failure or refusal to stop for Park Rangers or Park Manager: Will result in a \$25.00 fine for first (1st) offense. A \$50.00 fine for the second (2nd) offense. Violator will have to appear before the Board of Directors for third (3rd) offense.
 - C. Fines for assortment of other citations (including speeding): First (1st) warning. Second (2nd) warning. Third (3rd) citation is a \$25.00 fine. Forth (4th) is a \$50.00 fine. Fifth (5th) is a \$100.00 fine.
3. Quiet time is 11:00 p.m. – 8:00 a.m. Sun. thru Thurs. and 12:00 midnight – 8:00 a.m. Fri. and Sat.
4. Curfew for children 17 and under is 30 minutes after the last activity is scheduled to end.
5. Please do not remove fire rings and picnic tables from your lot and also keep fires at a reasonable level.
6. While we do welcome pets, they MUST be kept on a leash and cleaned up after.
7. Children under 7 should be accompanied by an adult when using the restroom.
8. Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult when using the pools or swimming in the beach area.
9. Children who are not potty trained are required to wear swim diapers. Adults accompanying children wearing swim diapers are responsible for monitoring them closely and changing them immediately when needed.
10. All visitors must register at registration upon arrival.
11. Any action deemed unacceptable by the management will result in being asked to vacate the property without refund of camping fees.
12. Jellystone Park Camp Resort or its owners are not responsible for accidents or for lost or stolen items.
13. Holiday reservations must be paid in full 10 days prior to arrival to secure assigned site.
14. 20% service charge on ALL cancellations.
15. Camping is an outdoor experience – NO refunds due to weather.
16. Bicycles should not be ridden after dark.
17. Only two (2) vehicles are allowed per campsite. All other vehicles should be parked in our overflow parking area.
18. Only one (1) camping vehicle is allowed per campsite. One tent may be erected on a lot with a camping vehicle but is only allowed to be erected for four (4) days in any given seven (7) day period.
19. Swimming in the lake is allowed only at the beach area and not after dark.
20. No fishing license is required.
21. Please do not dispose of baby wipes, diapers and feminine hygiene products through the toilets into the septic system.
22. Fireworks are prohibited from being used on owner or renter's site and/or common ground without written permission of the Board of Directors.
23. No Firearms shall be discharged within the confines of the property.
